Minutes

The minutes from the April 28, 2025 regular meeting were reviewed. After a brief discussion Mr. Bonner made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Ms. Krausert seconded the motion and all approved.

Bills

Ms. O'Halloran reviewed the invoices for approval and the financial activity since the last meeting with the Board. The check run totaled \$58,786.64 which included \$35,799.25 to Tribbett Agency for the annual commercial and auto insurance and \$16,705.05 to Witmer Public Safety for wildland gear that will be funded 100% by the Fire & Safety Grant. After a brief discussion. Mr. Royal made a motion to approve and pay the invoices as presented. Ms. Krausert seconded the motion and all approved.

The financials for May 2025 were presented and reviewed. Upon consensus, the Board accepted the Financial Reports as presented.

Chief's Report

Chief Kilduff reported that there are 48 people on the roster. All equipment is in service and there are no issues on water availability. There have been 33 calls since the last meeting for a total of 203 calls in 2025.

Eight new applicants are in process for joining the district

Firefighter 1 Academy has 10 weeks remaining

The new (used) engine will be placed into service on Tuesday morning, May 20, 2025

Response to tornado on Sunday, May 18, 2025 had damage to 19 homes but there were no injuries reported for citizens or responders. Mutual aid from Elizabeth Fire included 4 staff, 3 apparatus and Chief Steck. Rattlesnake had 24 staff, 10 apparatus and 2 command staff on scene.

Station 253 remodel plans are complete and permit proves has been started
